Teams Event Match Formats

- Teams shall consist of 4-6 players ranked in order of merit.
- Each team will play each other at least once in their age group
- Sets to be played are:-
 - 2 doubles and 4 singles
 - 10 & Under: singles and doubles
 - straight 6 game set
 - using a green dot ball
 - All other age groups: singles and doubles
 - 6 game set with tie-break at 5 games all
 - Using a yellow ball
 - o All matches are played with no-ad scoring (receiver's choice).

• Winning team to be determined by team wins, points, sets and games.

Eligibility

- U10's, U12's & U14's must be the stipulated age at 09 March 2024 and to be eligible to be included in the team and must have played four (4) Association interclub junior or senior matches prior to the commencement of the event.
- Open age players must be 17 and under as of round 1 of junior competitions and must have played four (4) Association interclub junior or senior matches prior to the commencement of the event.
